## 2025 CALL FOR CENTENARIANS

The Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS), Division of Senior Citizens (DSC) will celebrate our island's Centenarians in May 2025 as part of Senior Citizens Month. A *Centenarian* is any person who is or will be 100 years of age or older between January 1, 2025 and December 31, 2025. To be eligible for this recognition, the Centenarian must live in Guam as their main place of residence.

DSC encourages the public to be involved by informing a Centenarian or the Centenarian's family or caregiver about this special event. To participate, Biographical forms and Consent for Release of Information forms must be filled out for the Centenarian.
